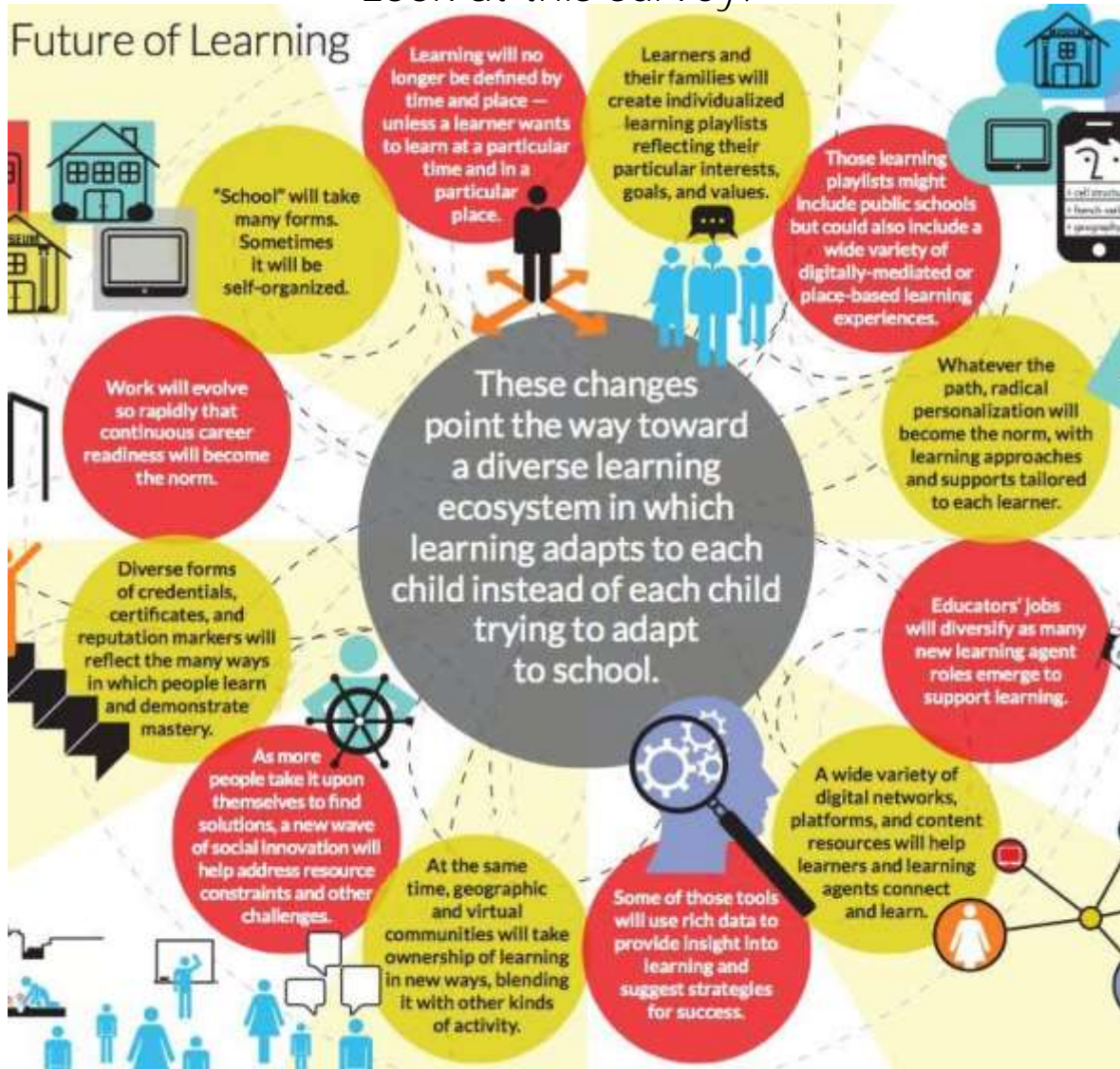

Summer School: Contemporary Fine Art Practice ART 101

What is contemporary fine art practice? This short five day course will explore the nature of contemporary fine art practice, enabling you to gain an understanding of its ideology and aims through practical exploration.

The five, one-day projects will be based on the themes of: performance, words, experience, physicality and collaboration. You will have the opportunity to experiment with photography, film, audio, the written word and elements of live art. A record of each of the five projects will be evidenced in your sketchbook on a daily basis.

3D Textiles ART 102

This short five day course will explore textures and surfaces through 2Dimensional and 3Dimensional design, media experimentation and by using laserfotology to manipulate images.

The five days will be packed with activities from photographing and stitching in and around the city of Brighton; manipulating the imagery you have collected by experimenting with scale; exploring shape, form and space through the use of multimedia mark making; creating a series of repeat patterns and layered images using Photoshop (introduction to) and creating a series of 3D images. The week of activity will culminate in the display of your work.

Summer School: Digital Filmmaking ART 103

This short 5 day course offers initial training in digital film editing. In this course you learn to perform basic editing functions while familiarising yourself with the user interface. You will be provided with editing material throughout the course but this could also be an opportunity to bring along some of your own footage to work on.

Through practical sessions using real editing examples you will learn professional editing skills that can be applied to all digital editing packages including: touring the Adobe Premiere CC interface; marking clips, using insert, overwrite and drag-and-drop editing; trimming edit points; using Ripple, Roll, and Extend edits; applying filters, changing motion properties and understanding key frames; audio editing; colour correction; formats; finishing and final output; Adobe Media Encoder.

Summer School: Website in a Day ART 104

Build your own website from scratch in a day. Please ensure you have a gmail account set up before you come and also gather any assets you may need (photographs, logos, videos etc) on a memory stick, external hard drive or Google Drive before the day.

This beginners course will have you up and running with a professionally designed website by the end of the day. We will use the online web site builder, 'Wix' to make this and you'll learn all the important design aspects for modern web development.

Summer School: Pottery ART 105

An introductory course working in ceramics.

Over the course of the week you will learn how to use a range of handbuilding techniques with clay, including pinching, slab building and coil building. You will use plaster moulds to make press moulded and slip cast pieces. You will learn how to create decorative surfaces in clay, using coloured slips, oxides and glazes. You will look at the work of other potters and be encouraged to develop design ideas for your own pieces. At the end of the week you will have produced an exciting range of work built in clay and decorated using a range of techniques.

We will provide a sketchbook and all materials. You will be provided with aprons but please wear clothing and footwear you don't mind getting a bit messy. You may want to bring a camera to record the process although this is not essential. Your work will be fired for you and will available for collection after the course finishes.
